ISO 9001:2008 is a Quality Management System Standard. The requirements in order to meet the ISO 9001:2008, Certification criteria are:

- Have a companywide policy manual
- Have documented procedures that outlines how each department functions
- Identify the documents (forms) needed to create company records
- Top Management (Corporate) is the moving force behind the company policies and procedures
- Employees are trained to do their jobs and tasks efficiently
- Production is planned out and controlled
- Products are inspected
- Failed products are quarantined
- When planned results fail, corrective action is taken so the error is fixed and does not recur

Today the work continues through the continued support of DDB. The schools we built are full, the churches we built are holding regular services and the agriculture projects are beginning to advance into other villages.

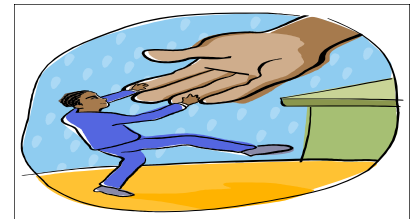
