Safety & Policy

Worker protection is the law of the land. All employees have the right to a safe workplace. The Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (OSH Act) was passed to prevent workers from being killed or otherwise harmed at work. The law requires employers to provide their employees with working conditions that are free of known dangers that could harm their employees.

At DDB Unlimited, Inc. we take the safety of our employees very seriously. In an effort to reduce the possibility of injuries to the feet, we are putting into affect a policy requiring all employees working on the production floor to wear safety shoes. This is in compliance with OSHA regulation 1910.136 requiring employers to assure all employees to use protective footwear where there is a danger of foot injury from falling or rolling objects, or objects piercing the sole. This policy takes effect on January 1st of 2015. If you have any questions regarding how this affects you please talk to your supervisor or HR Manager for additional information.


