All around Jeff is a great guy and if you just happen to be fortunate enough to call him a friend you are pretty lucky. You can always count on him in good times or bad.

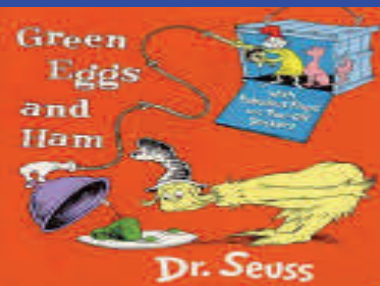

Prevention: Precautions Prevent Heat Related Illness

It is necessary to take precautions against high temperatures to avoid heat-related illnesses. High body temperatures can lead to damage to the brain or other vital organs and even death. A heat index of 108 is a potential health threat for ALL people and is particularly dangerous for high-risk groups; elderly, infants and children up to four years old, overweight people, and those with heart or respiratory problems.

The illnesses associated with heat exposure are: heat exhaustion which is usually associated with heavy activity caused from an excessive loss of water and salt contained in sweat; heat stroke occurs when the body temperature rises rapidly, the sweating system fails and the body is unable to cool down.

The best protection from the heat is to

stay indoors, preferably in an air-conditioned building. Fans only accelerate the rise in internal body temperature, therefore a cool shower or bath or moving to an air-conditioned place is a much better solution.

To avoid heat-related illness:

- Increase water consumption
- Conduct outdoor work or exercise in the early morning or evening when it is cooler; if you must work in the heat, take frequent breaks in a shade or air-conditioned area, drink plenty of water or electrolyte replacement beverage
- If not accustomed to the heat proceed gradually over several weeks
- Wear light-colored, loose fitting clothing
- Do not leave children, senior citizens or pets unattended in vehicles

-Wide-brimmed hats and sun screen protect against sunburn and heat related illnesses

-Seek accommodations in air-conditioned facilities during the heat of the day; malls, theaters, libraries, multi-service centers

-Take frequent cool baths or showers if your home is not air conditioned

I am amazed at how much the Lord wants to give to His children.

- 1) He wants to give us His entire Kingdom and He takes pleasure in doing so. *Lu 12:32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.*
- 2) He wants to give us whatsoever we ask for in His name so our joy might be full. *John 16:24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.*
- 3) He wants to and is able to do so much more for us than we can ask or even think. *Eph 3:20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,*
- 4) He wants to shower us with His benefits including forgiveness, healing, redemption from our destructive choices in life, loving kindness, tender mercies and renewed strength... *Ps 103:1-5 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.
