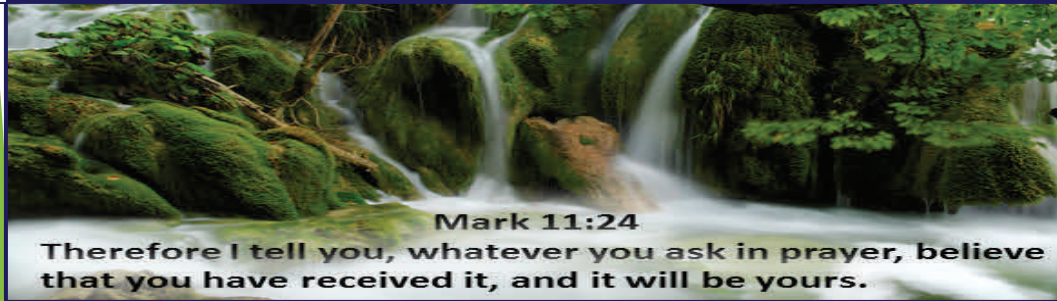

Safety Awareness

TORNADO PREPAREDNESS:

DDB has specific plans in place to keep its' employees safe during a tornado or other inclement severe weather event.

* There will be a Public Address for all employees to evacuate the building or you will be notified by a manager the need to evacuate.

* **IMMEDIATELY** begin exiting the building. Do not attempt to locate others personally. If you are concerned about a co-worker's whereabouts notify your manager or Steve Adamietz while you are exiting toward the Shelters. The managers have 2 way communication tools in place & will utilize these to verify locations of all employees.

* Employees should exit the building closest to the Storm Cellars.

* Go directly to your assigned Storm Shelter in a calm & orderly manner - ask your manager NOW if you do not

know your assigned Shelter.

* All employees will be accounted for & their presence verified via several means in place.

* If you are unable to get out of the building you should take cover in the Conference Room that can be accessed via Steve Adamietz' office or if you are in the South Warehouse take cover in the Lab that is located by the bathrooms.

* If you are a parent of a school age child please remember that the school systems will not release children during tornado warnings. Your children are at a greater risk in a vehicle with you during severe weather than they would be in a designated safe area at the school.

* Emergency Management Agencies strongly advise against attempting to outrun a storm while in your personal vehicle. This is due to potential large hail and

flying debris, hazardous road conditions including flooding / downed trees & power lines & also the erratic driving of others on the road. Although DDB cannot mandate its' employees to stay at the facility & take cover in the approved Storm Shelters, they greatly encourage you to think ahead and follow the Emergency Preparedness plan that is in place rather than putting your life at risk if there is a dangerous weather forecast about to strike the area.
