70% of the children of Sierra Leone cannot afford an education and they live their lives without this simple basic necessity. The vision Dusty Mahorney saw and supported was the ability to send as many kids to school as possible. Brenda & I were commissioned by the Lord, supported and sent by Dusty and DDB to build the schools, churches and industries to help transform this generation of kids. When this project began, GEM Ministries of Sierra Leone, had 2 private Christian schools that supported 40-50 children each. Today, with the support of DDB Unlimited we have opened 9 schools and are educating approximately 400-500 kids.

This Christian education will be their hope for a future life and it gives them the opportunity to rebuild their nation as they grow.
