




March Employee of the Month: Angel Miles

## **Words of Encouragement From Pastor Don**





Loved ones at DDB Unlimited,

Normally I would send an update about the work in Sierra Leone. This month however I want to send you all an encouraging word.

With the loss of our dear friend and great leader Dusty Mahorney just 14 months ago and now the loss of Sherri last month and the others we lost in-between, I know your grief is greater than you can put into words.

On my way to Sherri's funeral in Oklahoma I stopped to fuel up our car. Suddenly there appeared a Carolina Wren (bird) by the gas pump. His feathers were wounded and one of his legs missing. An indescribable compassion for that wounded bird rose up in my heart. I wanted to help him and had no ability to do so. THEN, the Lord spoke to me. He said, "You were designed as a whole man to function with 2 legs but it is possible to function and keep going even if you loose part of who you are..."

The Lord woke me around 2 AM the following morning (Saturday) and said, "do you remember the intense compassion you felt for the wounded bird you could not help?" Yes, I replied. "Well the amount of compassion I have for my children is multiplied times greater, far beyond understanding and I AM NOT LIMITED. I can do anything you need me to do and I am Faithful to perform everything I have promised..."
